- Resident Caretakers of apt. buildings with 9 to 60 suites: \$1,002.53 per month + \$40.17 per suite
- Resident Caretakers of apt. buildings with >60 suites: \$3,414.85 per month
- Alternate Piece Rates for Harvest Workers: Depends on crop

General Minimum Wage: \$15.30 per hour

Separate Minimum Wages: None (Security Guard minimum wage eliminated in Oct.

NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

General Minimum Wage: \$16.05 per hour

Separate Minimum Wages: None

Scheduled Increases:

• Annual CPI adjustment every September 1

NOVA SCOTIA

General Minimum Wage: \$15.20 per hour

Separate Minimum Wages:

- Alternate rates for logging, forestry, construction workers
- Separate minimum wage for inexperienced workers eliminated

Scheduled Increases:

• Annual CPI increases rounded to nearest nickel every April 1

NUNAVUT

General Minimum Wage: \$19.00 per hour

Separate Minimum Wages: None

Scheduled Increases:

• Reviewed every April 1 but increases not required.

ONTARIO

General Minimum Wage: \$16.55 per hour **Separate Minimum Wages:**

- Students under 18: \$15.60 per hour
- Liquor servers: Eliminated—now receive general minimum wage
- Hunting & fishing guides: \$82.85 per day (< 5 consecutive hours in a day)
- Hunting & fishing guides: \$165.75 per day (5 or more hours in a day, whether or not consecutive)
- Homeworkers: \$18.20 per hour

Scheduled Increases:

• Annual CPI adjustments every October 1

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

General Minimum Wage: \$15.40 per hour

Separate Minimum Wages: None

Scheduled Increases:

• Increases 60 cents to \$16.00 per hour on October 1, 2024

• Annual adjustments every May 1

SASKATCHEWAN

General Minimum Wage: \$14.00 per hour

Separate Minimum Wages: None

Scheduled Increases:

- October 1, 2024: \$1.00 increase to \$15.00 per hour
- Annual inflation increase every October 1

YUKON TERRITORY

General Minimum Wage: \$17.59 per hour **Separate Minimum Wages:**

- \$40.80 per hour for Category A Classworkers
- \$36.58 per hour for Category B Classworkers
- \$32.45 per hour for Category C Classworkers
- \$29.45 per hour for Category D Classworkers

• Annual CPI adjustments every April 1
