

Termination Notice Calculator



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Use this tool to calculate the minimum termination notice required under your jurisdiction employment standards law.

Step 1: Verify the employee is entitled to termination notice under the applicable employment standards law, no exemptions apply, and there is no employment contract or collective agreement requiring greater notice.

Step 2: Select the employee jurisdiction of employment.

Step 3: Enter length of employment using years and months only.

Step 4: For Ontario and federally regulated employers, complete the additional statutory severance section.

Employer payroll is \$2.5M or more

Permanent business discontinuance and 50+ employees severed within 6 months

Federal additional statutory severance applies for employees with at least 12 consecutive months of service.
